Lake Chaparral Rules and Regulations

In the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the property owners of Lake Chaparral and their guests, the Board of Directors publish the following set of rules and regulations. These rules and regulations will be enforced and fines may be issued.

BOATING RULES

Lake Chaparral

Maximum horsepower is 60 hp. Proof of horsepower and insurance must be turned in at the office and a permit obtained. Hours are 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. Keep a 50 ft margin between shore docks

Lake DeLago

Maximum horsepower is 7.5 hp.

Timberline Lake

Trolling motors only.

Observe the State of Kansas water rules of safety; general traffic patterns will be counter clockwise.

BEACH RULES

No pets

No fires

No obscene language

No glass containers

No disorderly conduct

No fishing

No boats or jet skis Clean up after yourself

No alcoholic beverages on the Beach

Be watchful and respectful of the children on the beaches

SWIMMING RULES

Swim at your own risk as there is no life guard on duty. Swimming is allowed from the swimming dock in DeLago Lake Children under the age of 12 shall be accompanied by an adult.

PUBLIC DOCK RULES

No boat or jet ski will be tied to any of the public docks.

Children under the age of 12 shall be accompanied by an adult.

No swimming nor diving from the fishing dock.

No rough-housing from the swimming dock.

The docks will be used at your own risk.

PARK RULES

The parks are designed to be used by the property owners and their guest. Leave the area better than you found it.

FISHING RULES

No trot-lines

No limb lines

No jug lines

No bow and arrow fishing

Do not clean fish in any of the public areas.

Do not fish in the designated beach areas.

The Fish and Lakes Committee has suggested the following limits on size and number of fish taken from our lakes:

Panfish (crappie, blue gill, sunfish)

20 per day

Largemouth Bass

Release 12" to 15" for spawning

Catfish

Release under 16" for spawning

The lakes are stocked for the best possible fishing conditions. Abiding by these suggestions will assist in guaranteeing the success of your fishing. Follow the guidelines set forth by the Kansas Fishing Regulations for handling and/or release of fish.

HUNTING RULES

Hunting is not allowed anywhere within the development. The discharge of any firearm is not allowed.

ROAD RULES

The maximum speed limit on any and all roads is 20 mph, except where posted.

There will be no parking on the roads at any time.

Vehicles must stop at all intersections so marked.

All motor vehicles operating within the development must be licensed and insured.

All off-road vehicles must be insured and proof of insurance registered in the office and a permit obtained.

MISCELLANEOUS RULES

- * Leaving your boat unattended over a period of a few days at any public area is not allowed.
- * The bathhouses are provided for the use of the property owners and their guests. Help keep them clean for the next person.
- * There is leash law in effect. All pets must be on a leash when not on the owner's property.
- * Littering the roadways, parks and beaches is an eyesore and irresponsible conduct.
- * Keep our waters clean. Don't throw waste products such as trash, garbage, cigarette butts, cans or bottles into the lake.
- * All property owners are responsible for their guest's actions.
- * No over the road vehicles are allowed on the development except to go to the host's property (tractors only); no overnight parking; tractor must be turned off and parked; speed limit 5 mph; must fill out registration form (obtainable at the office).
- * No obstructions or personal property in cul-de-sacs.
- * No burning on common properties or roadways.
